I was responsible for maintenance of the boats, engines, compressors and diving equipment. I can break down and over haul almost any regulator, BCD, compressor or any other diving related equipment used. I have actual working knowledge of gas blending (EANX & Trimix) as well as tank inspections and cleaning. I'm very handy with tools and rather creative when it comes to applying a fix in a bind. Problem solving is an area I excel in. I have over 5k dives with more than 300 deco dives of which 150 are to below 60m.

I am passionate about history and preserving relics from the past for the world to see. I'm used to long hours, hard work, little pay, and very skilled at finding productive ways to spend down time. No job is ever below me or too small nor is a job too big or above me. I am not afraid to ask questions when I don't know something and I learn very quickly.
